1. EXECUTIVE SESSION - Section 551.071 (2)

- 1.1 Consultation pursuant to Section 551.071 (2), Texas Government Code, to secure legal advice in connection with the request for an investigation under Section 143.009, Texas Local Government Code relating to the integrity of the sergeants' examination administered on February 28, 2017, and related legal matters. (Garza and Navarro)

Chair Chisler suggested that the commission move to executive session at 6:04pm to discuss the request to set aside the exam and eligibility list for the March 14, 2017 Sergeant exam.

Civil Service Director Garza reported her findings stating the exam had not been circulated, published or requested under the open records acts. The questions were shuffled and the exam was sealed and kept under lock and key to maintain its integrity. Neither candidate had knowledge that the exam given on February 28, 2017 would be the same as the exam given on November 30, 2015.

- 2.2 Consider and take all appropriate action, on a request, by TMPA Attorney Greg Cagle on behalf of Officer Shannon Oubre for an investigation into the integrity of the sergeant's examination administered on February 28, 2017. (Garza)

Chair Chisler stated:

It is the opinion of the commission, based on the investigation completed by Director Garza, that no facts were uncovered to be egregious enough to warrant setting aside the exam. As a result, no facts exist to warrant setting aside the eligibility list thus Mr. Cagle's request is denied.

Motion was made by Commissioner Doric and second by Chair Chisler.
