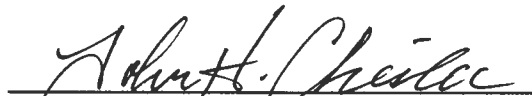
- 2.2 Adjourn

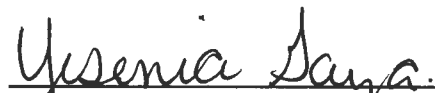
John Chisler made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and Joe Winter second the motion.
