61 **8.1** Consider and take all appropriate action on recommendation of the Public Safety Task Force
62 for 2021 expenditures from the Public Safety Fund in the amount of \$106,184.00. *Brad Goudie,*
63 *Director of Emergency Services*

64
65 Brad Goudie, Director of Emergency Services, explained that the Public Safety Task Force
66 met in November to consider public safety needs for the year. This fund program established in
67 2010 and based off of revenue generated from voluntary donation of \$3 per household.
68 Historically, expenditures recommended for approval and subsequent purchases have been based
69 on the revenue generated during the prior year, and this past year returned \$107,359.53 in revenue.
70 In addition, the practice has to set aside 10% of the revenues in reserves for unplanned
71 emergencies. Once all the requests were in for this year, the total projected expenditures were
72 \$106,184.00. The Public Safety Task Force determined that all requests were justified and is
73 recommending approval, which would require pulling some monies from reserves. Reserves have
74 not been utilized in 10 years of the existence of this fund, and dipping into reserves for the proposed
75 expenditures will leave a balance of \$158,489.00. Specifics on requested expenditures can be
76 seen in Attachment A.

86 Bike Sidewalk/Trail on E. Meyer to the Harris County Precinct 2 Partnership Project program for
87 2021. *Gayle Cook, City Manager and Brian Craig, City Engineer and Assistant Director of*
88 *Public Works*

90 Gayle Cook, City Manager, explained that this project was brought forth by staff when
91 Harris County Precinct 2 opened up grant opportunities for 50/50 matching for capital projects and
92 maintenance projects. Staff is proposing the construction of a pedestrian friendly pathway along
93 the east-west trail connection all the way up to the intermediate school. This application would be
94 for a sidewalk connection up to N. Meyer, with the remaining L shape to Seabrook intermediate
95 constructed through a second grant, Safe Routes To School, and project for the City in the FY21-
96 22 budget process. Tonight's project is scoped two different ways: one for granite and one for
97 concrete. The County may require concrete. On higher end, for concrete, the match estimate is
98 \$218,000. There are available funds in CIP funds to cover this project.

107 **8.3** Consider and take all appropriate action on the approval of an Application for the Todville
108 Road Bridge to the Harris County Precinct 2 Partnership Project program for 2021. *Gayle Cook,*
109 *City Manager and Brian Craig, City Engineer and Assistant Director of Public Works*

111 Ms. Cook explained that this project was identified staff. The Todville bridge is a little
112 lower than other portions of the bridge and is an aged piece of infrastructure. This piece does go
113 under water when there is a heavy rain or significant weather event. This project was sent to the
114 County last year, but was not accepted at the level the City was seeking. County is looking for
115 complete 50/50 match. The scope is almost \$4 million, which includes City's waterline that runs
116 along the bridge as well as a lift station. This road and infrastructure is really the County's, so city
117 is proposing taking on 23% of the cost, at \$906,000.00 from enterprise funds, for water and
118 sanitation portion of this project. There are funds available for this project. County is willing to
119 look at it for under a 50/50 match.

129 funding from the Seabrook Economic Development Corporation for Commercial Road Project to
130 the Harris County Precinct 2 Partnership Project program 2021. This item was approved by the
131 Seabrook EDC Board of Directors on January 14, 2021. *Paul Chavez, Director of Economic*
132 *Development and Brian Craig, City Engineer and Assistant Director of Public Works*

Paul Chavez, Director of Economic Development, stated during a previous EDC meeting, this project was reviewed as an incentive project. The Board of Directors of the Seabrook Economic Development Corporation has an objective is to work in tandem with the City on potential projects that would benefit economic development for the City. The development of commercial road would open up the development of the light industrial zoning district on the north side and would encourage heavy truck traffic to utilize the commercial road and not Red Bluff Road. The SEDC Board has been very diligent with getting monies back into the community. For FY21-22, this commercial road project has been added as a potential expense, as a 50% match with Harris County. The SEDC Board is continuing to take a conservative approach on sales tax revenue; nevertheless, those revenues are over-performing and continuing to beat projections. This project will leave a healthy fund balance.

Ms. Cook explained that this item needs to be withdrawn and pulled from the agenda because there has not been an agreement able to be made with Harris County at this time; therefore, this item was withdrawn from consideration and action by the City Council.

Boat Ramp

TXDot has contracted with a consultant to review any and all options for the relocation and redevelopment of the Seabrook Boat Ramp. There is an initial review to look at the removal a portion of rail berm for access into Clear Creek Channel. Further study will be needed to determine feasibility and parking configuration options. * Bath Street has been identified with conflicts with the foundations of the extension of the bridge and will require rerouting the street.



SH 146 Expansion - Red Bluff to Spencer

This project is anticipated to let in **August 2021**, and will add one lane in each direction, reconstruct the bridge over Little Cedar Bayou, add sidewalks along frontage roads, adding three southbound frontage lanes from Port to Red Bluff.

Capital Improvement Projects (CIP)

Pine Gully Wastewater Treatment Plan Retrofit \$35,946,438 (C.O.s/HMGP) -Pending

This project is the complete infrastructure retrofit of the City's Waste Water System to include the relocation of the treatment plant from Main Street to a site located adjacent to the new Public Works facility. This project contains both phases (phase 1 - design; phase 2 - construction) of the waste water system retrofit. The City's existing WWTP suffered significant damage during Hurricane Ike due to its location to Galveston Bay.

Phase I – Complete Design and Engineering

Phase II – Pending Approval for Construction Grant with Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)

SH 146 City Utility Relocates (CIP W7 and WW8) \$3,694,358 (SIB) Pending last phase

The purpose of this project is to relocate the existing water and sewer line facilities with the existing TxDOT SH146 ROW to a location outside of the new proposed highway improvements.

Friendship Elevated Water Tower Project (W11) \$350,000 (Impact Fees) Pending final inspection

To ensure the public water supply storage tanks are in safe and productive working order and in compliance with the TCEQ & EPA environmental rules and regulations. The project will include replacing protective coating systems and performing minor structural repairs.

SMART Meter (CIP FAC6) \$3,000,000 (C.O.s 2020) Pending Delivery of Cost Estimate

AMI water meter conversion program will upgrade manual read water meters to AMI type installations. Project will also include the implementation of behavior-based software – such as WaterSmart, DropCounter, or other providers – using the data provided by the AMI system. This software will help customers identify leaks on the customer side of the meter, and will also promote municipal conservation measures appropriate to their homes or facilities. This project includes replacing all of the City's water meters.

Seascape and Baybrook Subdivision HCFCD Bond E-07 (D11 and D12) \$2,238,000 (Total Project Cost) Pending Kick Off

2018 HCFCD Bond project to modify the Red Bluff Road drainage crossing to F220-02-00 tributary, perform detail study of the storm sewer system in Seascape Subdivision Sec.2 and make improvements based on the study. As part of the Certificates of Obligation recently issued for 2020, Seascape and Baybrook Subdivision drainage improvement projects were approved as a 50%/50% partnership. Engineering with the County has completed environmental assessments and staff has met on design options.

Red Bluff Road Expansion TxDOT and Harris County Project Est. Completion April 2021

The project will construct two eastbound traffic lanes and convert the existing roadway to a one-way westbound operation. The project will improve the roadway on the existing bridge over Taylor Lake to include the addition of a new bridge parallel to the existing bridge. This existing bridge, located north of the new bridge, will be re-striped to two lanes of westbound traffic. The new bridge will include two lanes of eastbound traffic and a 10-foot-wide pedestrian walkway.

The end of January 2021, the railroad conflict is anticipated to be removed at the eastern portion of the project near SH 146 to allow for the completion of paving. Traffic plan modifications to switch traffic to new lanes was rejected and traffic will remain in current flow during this phase.



El Mar Ditch HCFCD Bond E-07 (D2) \$3,905,527 (Total Project Cost) Pending Design from Harris County and Public Meeting

This ditch is in the center of El Mar Lane and is too shallow to provide proper drainage to the subdivision area or the commercial area along SH146 that is connected to it. The City has attempted to improve the drainage within the Miramar Subdivision several times, but the depth of this channel has precluded reaching a satisfactory outcome that stretches from Meyer to Hester Gully to the bay. The intent would be to provide a 100-year storm capacity for the SH146 & Miramar area.

Rail Spur Project (Port of Houston and FUSED Industries)

Construction of approximately 6500 track feet of rail at the Bayport Terminal. This rail will cross State Highway (SH) 146 and connect the existing rail from Strang Rail line to within 900 feet of the Container Freight Station (CFS) Road in the Bayport Intermodal Facility. This project will also include clearing, grubbing, drainage, rail crossings, signalization and perhaps a sound wall, if required.

Next phase in this project is identified as Phase III consisting of traffic control crews to remove all temporary materials and install precast panels and rails on frontage road where the rail will cross. 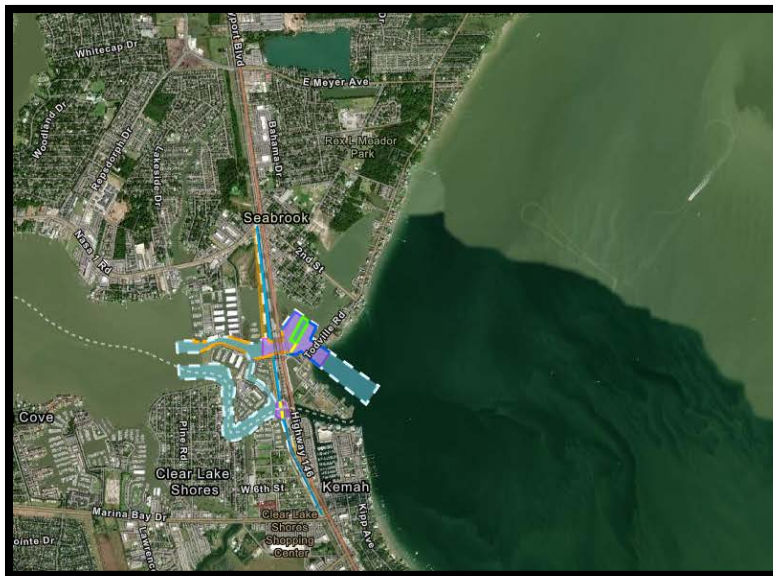

Community Projects Update**Coastal Texas Study**

The Coastal Texas Study is a 5.5 year, \$19.8M comprehensive study led by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in partnership with its non-federal cost-share sponsor, the Texas General Land Office. The purpose of the study to identify feasible projects that reduce risks to public health and the economy, restore critical ecosystems, and advance coastal resiliency.

The results of the engineering, economic and environmental examinations will result in a final recommended plan that consists of coastal storm risk management and ecosystem restoration features. Resolution**Draft Proposal****Clear Lake Gate System**

There are two inlets from Galveston Bay into Clear Lake. Our plan proposes the construction of a 75-foot floating sector gate in the southernmost inlet to accommodate boat traffic into and out of Clear Lake. The sector gate would have a sill elevation of -10 feet to match the authorized depth of the existing channel. To the right and left of the sector gate, we propose to add in circulation gates to address potential water quality concerns and assure tidal flow between the inlet and Clear Lake.

In the northernmost inlet, a pumping station would be needed so that, when the gates are closed, water coming down from the watershed (due to rainfall) would be pumped out to the Bay. The pumping station would have a designed capacity of 20,000 cubic feet per second.

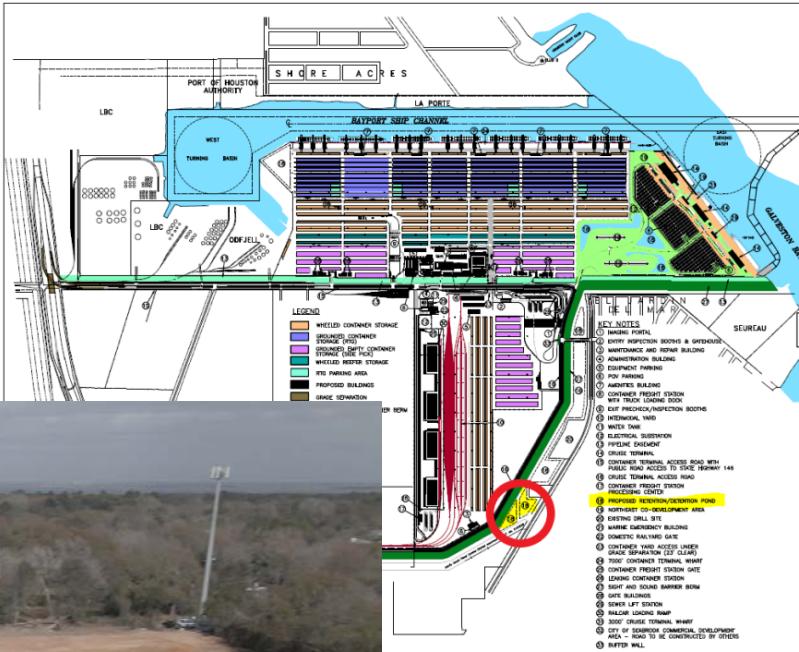

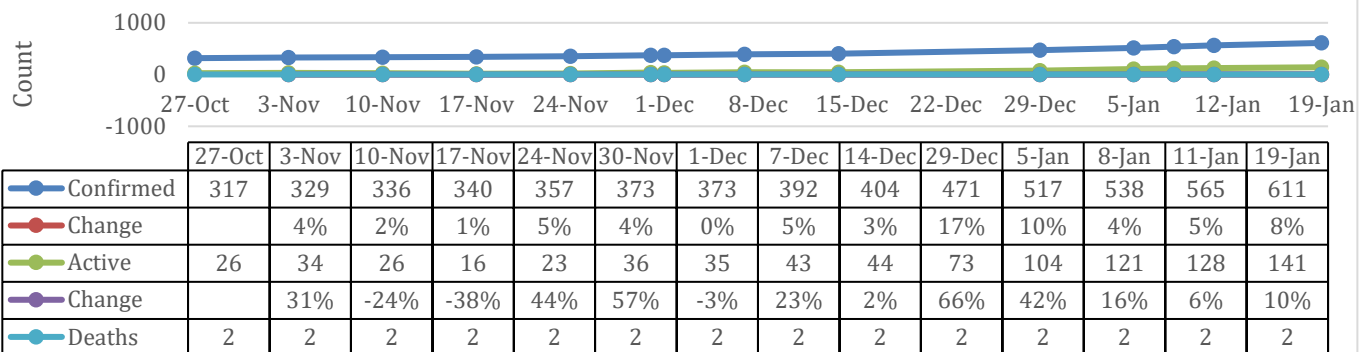

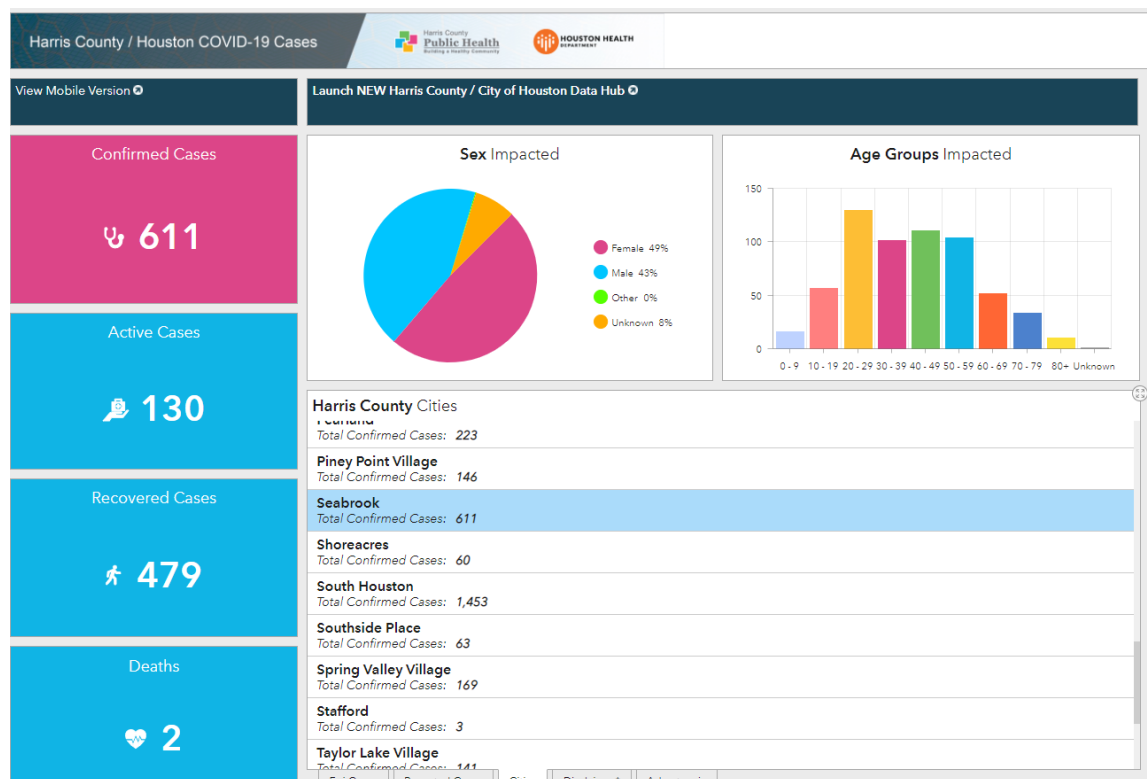
