- Gayle Cook discussed that the contract extension between Seabrook and Wells Fargo Bank until June 30, 2023

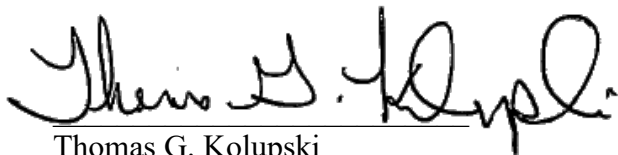
3. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM (CIP) WORKSHOP
