Gayle Cook, City Manager updated and clarified the Park Improvement Fund, a special fund. She also made staff recommendations as to how this fund could be handled in future budgets.

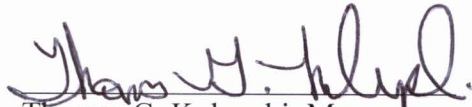
3. HOT SPONSORSHIPS

Consider and take all appropriate action on the allocation of funds for events to be funded with Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) for FY 2022/2023. Compliance for HOT funding expenditures requires that there must be a finding (1) that the expenditure directly promotes tourism and the convention and hotel industry, and only if (1) is so determined, (2) that the expenditure is a permissible use as approved by statute (i.e. advertising to promote tourism; promotion of the arts, etc.)
