

**Notice of Project of the Seabrook Economic
Development Corporation**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Seabrook Economic Development Corporation ("SEDC") intends to undertake a project for economic development including expenditures consistent with the purposes and duties as a Type B corporation by providing incentives to Tookie's Seafood through SEDC sales tax revenue abatement for a specified amount and time period. Payment for such expenditures is authorized for projects under Texas Local Government Code sections 505.152, 505.158, and 505.302, and is being used for the purpose of promoting new and expanded business enterprises in or near the City of Seabrook.

Pursuant to Texas Local Government Code section 505.160 and 505.302, proceeds of the sales tax imposed under Chapter 505 may be used to pay the costs of projects of the types added to the definition of "project" by Subchapter D, unless, not later than the 60th day after the date of this notice, the City Council of the City of Seabrook receives a petition signed by more than 10 percent of the registered voters of the municipality requesting that an election be held before tax proceeds may be used to promote new or expanded business development.
