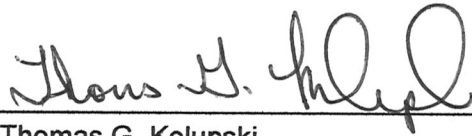
3.1 Establish future meeting dates and agenda items.
