



**MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 4, 2025**

**SEABROOK PARKS AND TRAILS COMMITTEE
MEETING**

Committee Chair Flores called the Seabrook Parks and Trails Committee to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Public Works and Animal Control Complex Training Room. Present were Nehemiah Jackson, Sally Antrobus, John Coggeshall, David Popken, Monica Flores, Debra Harper, Jesse Jones.

1. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Parks & Trails Committee Member Sally Antrobus congratulated Parks & Trails Committee members Debra Harper and Monica Flores for the awards they received at the 2025 Seabrook Volunteer Appreciation Dinner.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Meeting with Ethan Beeson regarding the Keep Texas Beautiful Grant proceeds project

This item took place after Items 2.2 and 2.3

Ethan Beeson appeared via Zoom video conference to discuss the approval of the location for the statue location proposed by the Seabrook Parks & Trails Committee.

2.2 Discussion regarding the Parks & Trails Committee involvement in the Bayside Park expansion project at the Main Street Wastewater Treatment Plant

This item was discussed prior to Item 2.1 as the Committee waited for Ethan Beeson to log in on the Teams meeting.

Member Jones informed the committee that the Bayside Park Stakeholders Ad Hoc Committee members gave a presentation at the August 19, 2025 Joint City Council & EDC meeting.

2.3 Discussion regarding Parks & Trails Sign Committee review

Discussion for this item began prior to Item 2.1; however, Ethan Beeson logged into the Teams meeting, so the remaining discussion occurred after Item 2.1 concluded.

Member Coggeshall announced that the Parks & Trails Sign Committee review members had their third and final meeting and that all business owners were pleased with the presentation given at City Council. A professional sign designer will be hired to give their recommendation for signage throughout the City.

2.4 Discussion regarding the design of the Wildlife Park parking lot

The Committee discussed the parking lot design for Wildlife Park parking lot. Public Works Director, Brian Craig, discussed that CenterPoint is working on adding a transformer and that Geogrid will be the material used for the parking lot design.

- Member Jones discussed the repairs that were made to the wooden bridges at Pine Gully (**See Attachment A**).
- Member Jones announced that Bayside Park will host RC boat races on September 5, 2025.
- Member Jones discussed a mobile restroom option for use in City parks and for City events (**See Attachment B**).

4.2 Update and report on various Seabrook Park items including community events, emergency events, and grant administration

Public Works Director, Brian Craig, and Assistant Public Works Director, Jesse Olivo, announced the following:

- Kid Fish will be held on September 13, 2025.
- The removal of a dangerous ramp at the skate park.
- The removal of trees in the Trails.
- Demolition on the Wastewater Treatment plant may begin in a month or 2.

The Parks & Trails Committee announced the following:

- Fall Sweep will be held on November 1, 2025.
- Member Jones informed the committee that he received a large donation of Blue Bonnet seeds.

4.3 Consider and take all appropriate action on a recommendation to Council on a new trail that would run from Public Works/ Animal Control to the intersection of Bayview and down Bayview to Hwy 146.

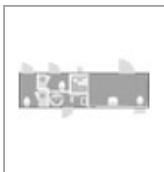

ADA 6x23' Shower Plus 2, 3-Station

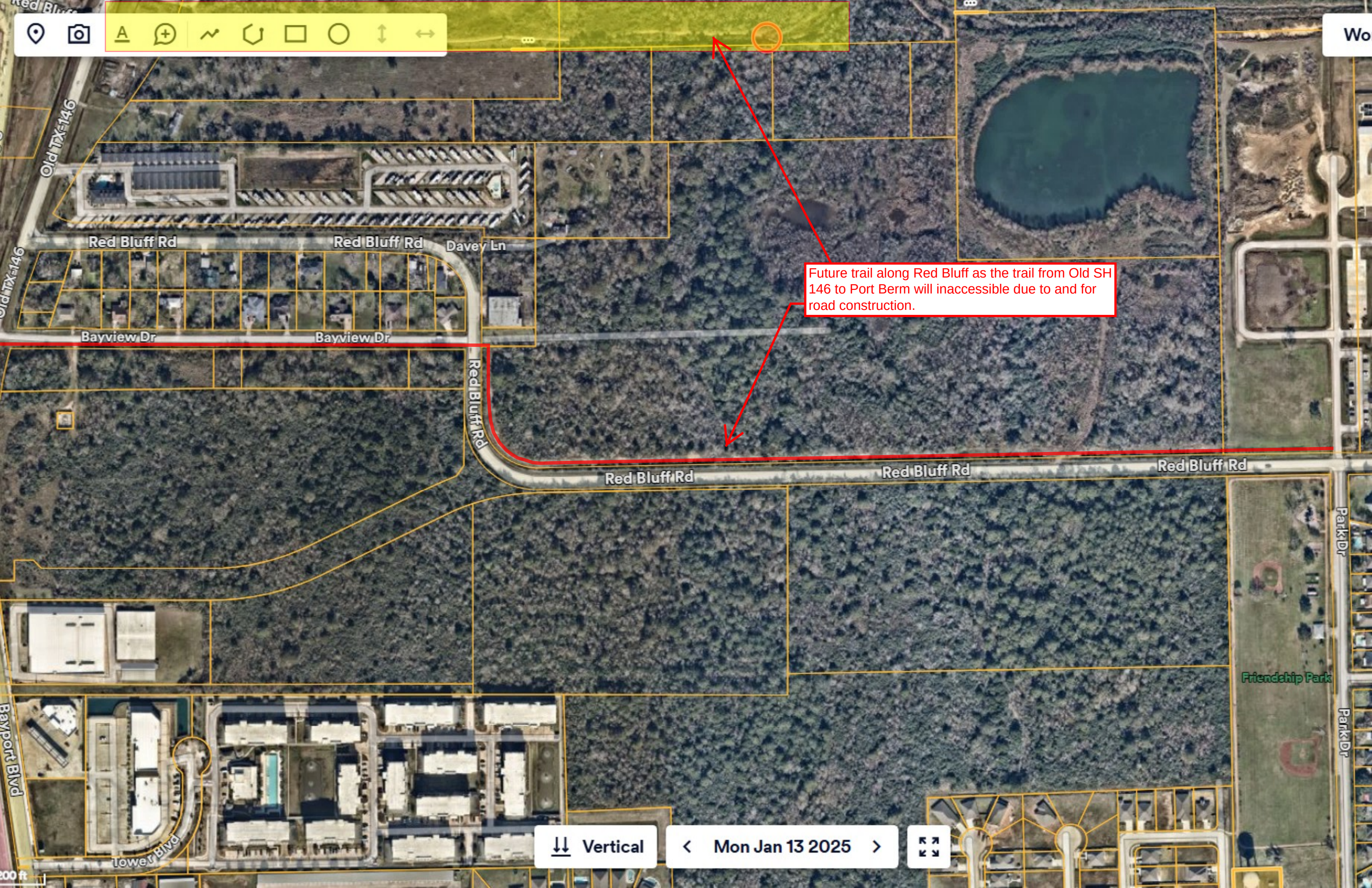

An ADA shower, combined with two standard restroom stalls, offers a single solution for events, campsites, and construction sites needing both. The trailer rides on an air suspension system, making it easy to tow and even easier to lower and level. The wheels, attached to stub axles, disengage quickly and the air suspension system lowers the trailer gently to the ground. Once the trailer is in place, simply lower the attached platform, snap on the six-foot ramp, slide in the handrails and set-up is complete. The ramp has a very slight angle and the platform provides plenty of room for navigating and opening the door.

And with all Satellite Suites ADA trailers, the waste is removed by a highly efficient vacuum system. The advantage of this system over macerating toilets is the speed and distance waste is removed. It evacuates immediately upon flushing and can be pumped up to 100 feet away depending on site conditions. This system also evacuates foreign objects much easier. The system grinds the waste or objects, even items such as t-shirts or diapers, without clogging the system.
