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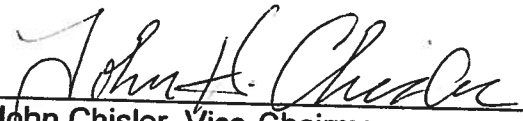
59 Gayle Cook explained that with only two individuals on the current Eligibility List, there

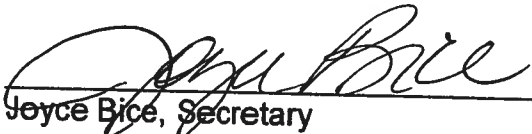
