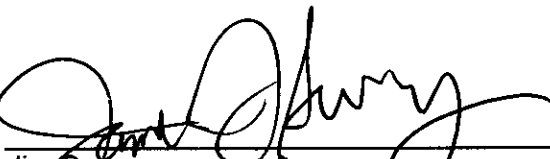
- 2.2 Administration of the Oath of Office to newly elected member for Council Position 3, and issuance of the Certificate of Election.**

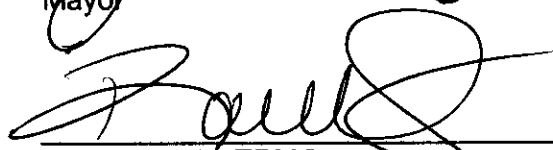
