AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, CHAPTER 10, "ANIMALS," ARTICLE I, "IN GENERAL, SECTION 10-1 "DEFINITIONS", TO ADD A DEFINITION OF "*ANIMAL AT LARGE*"; ARTICLE III, "DOGS AND CATS," DIVISION 2, "LICENSE," SECTION 10.94 "TAGS" TO REQUIRE BOTH CATS AND DOGS TO BE LICENSED AND WEAR SUCH LICENSE TAGS; AND ARTICLE IV, "CARE AND CONTROL," DIVISION 1, "GENERALLY," SECTION 10-121, "DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE" TO AMEND THE TITLE TO "ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE" WITH RELATED AMENDMENTS TO PROHIBIT ALL ANIMALS FROM RUNNING AT LARGE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2000, OR AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND NOTICE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, CHAPTER 100, "VEHICLES FOR HIRE", ARTICLE II. "AUTOMOBILE WRECKER SERVICE", BY AMENDING DIVISION I. "GENERALLY", SECTION 100-26, "DEFINITIONS," BY ADDING A NEW DEFINITION; AND BY AMENDING DIVISION II. "PERMIT", SECTION 100-68, "ISSUANCE, MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS, INSURANCE," BY ADDING REQUIREMENTS TO STORAGE FACILITIES, ESTABLISHING LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR TOW OPERATORS, REQUIRING THAT MOVING A TOWED VEHICLE IS DEPENDENT UPON THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER/DESIGNEE AND ENUMERATING INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

THIS ORDINANCE PROVIDES FOR A PENALTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500, OR AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW FOR VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF BY INCLUSION INTO THE CODE; REPEALS ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDES FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDES FOR NOTICE AND EFFECTIVE DATE.
